So, what does the PTA do?

Short Version:

- The PTA brings together the school community, typically through fundraising events.
- Those fundraising events support a variety of school needs:
 - Largest expense from PTA:
 - Kindergarten Teaching Assistants (aka Kindergarten TAs)
 - Second Largest:
 - _Staff Professional Development Curriculum Training: Literacy, DEI Training, Ed
 Tech Training, etc
 - o Third Largest:
 - o In School Enrichment Programs Coding, Ballet Tales, Art Farm

So, what does the PTA do?

Long Version:

The PTA works with the River School administration to best support our school. Our main objective is to fundraise, and through those funds we are able to support Kindergarten TAs, in school enrichment programs for all grades to supplement the academic curriculum, to community building efforts such as providing lunch for staff on professional development days, supporting the costs of trial initiatives such as recess coaches; we also earmark funds to bridge equity gaps ensuring that all students are able to participate in field trips, have the supplies they need for school .

During our events we aim to engage as many parents as possible, giving everyone an avenue and option to contribute to our collective success.






More Ways to be involved!



How to stay connected & informed: 3 ways!


1. Join the Parent Square PTA Group

Step 2: Click on Participate




Step 3: Click on "Groups" and join PS281 Parent Teacher Association through the "Join" button on the right
